An AIA trial should not be viewed in isolation. A co-pending litigation and the AIA trial are part of a coordinated litigation strategy where each forum presents an opportunity for both parties to improve its overall position. This panel will discuss how the parties can leverage timing to their respective benefit as well as how practical considerations can be the difference between success and failure.

Fintiv Update / Interplay with Co-Pending Litigation Panel 1 – The Trial

The fight does not end with a PTAB FWD. Estoppel and follow-on challenges to other claims present a fertile area for parties to improve their overall litigation positions. Limits on appeals, as well as practical appeal strategies, can further impact the overall value that an AIA trial can bring to the table.
